

Day 1

Arrive at BIA and transfer to Galle Face Hotel, Colombo and relax well for the next day early start.

Day 2

Leave the hotel with packed breakfast and reach the Fort Railway Station by latest 5.15am to get onboard the 5.45am train which will reach the Jaffna Railway Station by 12'noon. Check into North Gate by Jetwing to refresh and have a snack. Leave to board the yacht in Kurikkaduwan Jetty (approximately 1 hour from the hotel) at 4pm. The captain welcomes guests, and sets sail at sunset in front of Nanaitivu Island and its wonderful templates.



Day 3

Breakfast on board while sailing to islands of Analathivu for relaxed swimming and Eluvathivu for an onshore visit. Lunch on board near Eluvathivu. Afternoon sail to Nainaitivu (1h). Visit of the island and famous Nagadeepa Viharaya and Nagapooshani Amman Temple.

Day 4

Early breakfast with a 9am departure for 2 hour sail to Delft Island. A local guide will share the history of this unique island famous for its Dutch history, coral walls and wild miniature horses. Local seafood lunch on Delft Island. Swim in waters off the Coast of Delft Island and return to the yacht for dinner.

Day 5

After breakfast, on shore exploration of the archeological site of Jaffna Fort with a guide. Visit to the Nallur Temple artisanal woodcraftsman village. Followed by a traditional lunch in a Tamil home. Explore the exquisite Hammenheil Fort and return to anchorage and dinner on board.

Day 6

Breakfast on board will be followed by a departure towards Talaimannar. Guests will visit Adam's Bridge, a unique formation of a chain of limestone shoals and a mythical bridge connecting India and Sri Lanka and Talaimannar Pier. Return to anchorage for swimming. Dinner on board at Talaimannar.

Day 7

Breakfast and early morning sailing towards Kakarative. Onshore visit of the tiny island inhabited only by migrant fisherman and migrant sea birds. Guests can snorkel in the regenerating reef. Lunch onboard and departure for Nainativu. Arrival at sunset to sail in front of the Nagadeepa Temple. Dinner on board.

Day 8

After breakfast onboard, guests will disembark at 10am, at Kurrikaduwan Jetty and proceed to Lake Lodge Boutique Hotel, Dambulla (approximately 6 hours)

Day 9

Drive to Sigiriya airport (30mins) and get onboard the scheduled air taxi which departs @12.15pm to Colombo @12.45pm, drive to the Mirissa Fisheries Harbour (approximately 3 hours) and get onboard the yacht @4pm and set sail to Tallala beach. Walk the white sand beach in either direction, get some sun, or enjoy a relaxing swim. Sunset dinner served onboard.



Day 10

Breakfast onboard as the crew sets sail to search for the whales. Lunch served onboard at Mirissa beach. Afternoon surfing or visiting Weligama. Dinner onboard near Snake Island in Weligama Bay.

Day 11

The guests may encounter more Whales enroute to Galle. Arrive at Jungle beach for lunch. Afternoon onshore visit the World Heritage site Dutch Fort of Galle. Dinner onboard near Jungle Beach.

Day 12

After breakfast, sail to Mirissa Bay around 11am and enjoy swimming, snorkeling or stand up paddle boarding while the chef prepares the lunch. The cruise ends at 1pm. Proceed to Galle Fort Hotel for an overnight (approximately 1 hour), further explore Galle Fort.

Day 13

After breakfast drive to the airport (BIA) in time for your departure flight home (approximately 2.5 hour)
