


Day 4: Mooloolaba, Queensland, Australia

Day 15: Koror, Palau

Fri 15 Mar 2024 | Arrive 9:00am - Depart 5:00pm

East of the Philippines lies Koror—part of the tiny island nation of Palau. Your gateway to once-in-a-lifetime nature experiences, this port is best explored on an immersive Azamara cruise. Swim with harmless jellyfish, explore stunning coral reefs, and learn about local lore and legend.

Days 18-19: Manila, Philippines

But one of the best known, and not to be missed sites is Intramuros – the remnants of the walled settlement founded by the Spanish in 1571.

With 1,200+ skyscrapers, Hong Kong is a vertical city, so for great skyline views, take a tram to the top of Victoria Peak. Better still, hop on the tram between Kennedy Town and Shau Kei Wan for a cost-effective city tour. Head to Central for the world's longest outdoor escalator system and the incredible nightlife of Lan Kwai Fong. For a much quieter day, take a ferry to Lamma or Lantau Island.

Day 23: At Sea

Days 24-25: Halong Bay, Vietnam

Sun 24 - Mon 25 Mar 2024 | Arrive 8:00am on Day 24 – Depart 1:00pm on Day 25

In Hanoi's Old Quarter thousands of the buildings are over 100 years old and the streets are named after the wares that were traditionally sold on them such as Hang Bac (silver), Hang Ma (paper), and Hang Go (wood). Get a taste for daily life at Hoan Kiem Lake, the centrepiece of Hanoi. You'll see folks of all ages doing tai chi, couples strolling hand in hand, and lots and lots of motorbikes.

Day 26: Da Nang (Hue & Hoi An), Vietnam

Tue 26 Mar 2024 | Arrive 8:00am - Depart 8:00pm

Vietnam's third-largest city is the ideal gateway to explore the rich culture and history of this engaging and enigmatic country. Head to Hue on the Perfume River and experience an immense imperial city with temples, galleries, pavilions and museums. The small town of Hoi An is a charming contrast to the big city, with intricately carved facades on dozens of shops offering up unique gifts.

Day 27: At Sea

Days 28-29: Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam

Thu 28 – Fri 29 Mar 2024 | Arrive 10:00am on Day 28 – Depart 1:00pm on Day 29

Whether you call it Saigon or Ho Chi Minh City, this charming port by any other name would still be as sweet. It's filled with French colonial architecture and Asian influences, and many traditional French-style homes have been converted into trendy restaurants serving Vietnamese cuisine. (Be sure to try a Bahn Mi sandwich!) Must-sees include the Jade Emperor Pagoda and the Ben Thanh market.

Day 30: At Sea

Days 31-33: Bangkok (Klong Toey), Thailand

Sun 31 Mar – Tue 2 Apr 2024 | Arrive 1:00pm on Day 31 – Depart 2:00pm on Day 33

Bangkok is a city steeped in contrast. Gold-spired temples share space with the neon glow of red-light districts, mega-malls sit across the street from street markets, and everywhere you look carts serving incredible food sit in the shadows of white-linen restaurants. Grand Palace and Wat Pho are very popular sites, but no matter where your travels take you, be sure to experience a Tuk Tuk ride.

Day 34: Koh Samui, Thailand

Wed 3 Apr 2024 | Arrive 8:00am – Depart 2:00pm

The island of Koh Samui is a tiny tropical paradise, lined with coconut trees, white sand beaches, and stunning blue water. Snorkel in the waters, visit the Big Buddha at Bang Rak beach, and head inland to the rainforest to see spectacular waterfalls at Na Muang. If you're really looking for an escape, retreat to one of the many full-service spas found in the hotels around Chaweng and Lamai beaches.

Days 36-37: Singapore

Fri 5 – Sat 6 Apr 2024 | Arrive 8:00am on Day 36 – Depart 5:00pm on Day 37

Sink your teeth into this foodie's paradise and be sure to try the unofficial dish of the city, chili crab. If eating can be considered the national pastime in Singapore, shopping makes a decent case as the

second most popular activity. Head to Orchard Road where miles upon miles of shopping malls await featuring everything from the trendiest fashions to the latest electronic gadgets.

Day 38: Kuala Lumpur (Port Klang). Malaysia

Sun 7 Apr 2024 | Arrive 8:00am – Depart 8:00pm

As you explore the bustling streets of Kuala Lumpur, look up – way up – to the 88-story Petronas Towers; the pride of the city and the ultimate symbol of futuristic development. The two main pastimes in Kuala Lumpur are shopping and eating – browse more than 66 shopping malls before finishing the day at the famous kedai kopi shops – a refreshing take on the traditional food court.

Day 39: At Sea

Day 40: Sabang, Indonesia

Tue 9 Apr 2024 | Arrive 8:00am – Depart 5:00pm

For gorgeous views of the bay across the peninsula to Kasih Beach, venture to Kota Ata, where you'll also find colonial buildings, a vestige to its former Dutch residents. The real appeal is the atmosphere of Sabang and its people. Some locals say the island's name comes from the phrase santai banget, meaning very relaxed. Whether it's true or not, after your visit to Sabang, you're sure to agree.

Days 41-42: At Sea

Day 43: Hambantota, Sri Lanka

Fri 12 Apr 2024 | Arrive 8:00am - Depart 6:00pm

Sri Lanka's southern coast is a treasure trove of biodiversity and Hambantota is the gateway to most of it. Yala National Park holds the world's largest concentration of leopards and elephants, while Uda Walawe National Park rivals the savannahs of Africa. The UNESCO World Heritage-protected Galle Fort is an 18th-century Dutch walled town with chic shops, grand colonial houses, and beautiful beaches.

Day 44: Colombo, Sri Lanka

Sat 13 Apr 2024 | Arrive 8:00am – Depart 5:00pm

This teardrop-shaped island gem offers engaging encounters both in the capital city and the surrounding countryside. Wind your way through the streets of Colombo's old quarter to find some world-famous tea and explore eclectic cafés and shops. Trek out into the jungle and meet the friendly residents of a elephant orphanage.

Days 45-46: Kochi (Cochin), India

Sun 14 – Mon 15 Apr 2024 | Arrive 2:00pm on Day 45 – Depart 5:00pm on Day 46

The mixture of cultures and influences in Cochin – from giant Chinese fishing nets at Fort Kochi and a 400-year-old synagogue to ancient mosques and Portuguese-style homes – is a reminder of the city's history as the former centre of the Indian spice trade. But don't mistake this combination of old and new, east and west as being inharmonious; Cochin is actually a renowned centre for Ayurvedic medicine.

Days 48-49: Mumbai, India

Wed 17 – Thu 18 Apr 2024 | Arrive 8:00am on Day 48 – Depart 6:00pm on Day 49 $\,$

Amid all the hustle and bustle, Mumbai is buzzing with adventures to discover. To get a sense of the region's history, visit the Dr Bhau Daji Lad Mumbai City Museum, where you'll find over 3,500 objects telling Mumbai's story. To escape the hustle and bustle, travel to Elephanta Island, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, to tour the maze of cave temples and impressive temple carvings.

Days 50-51: At Sea

Day 52: Muscat, Oman

Sun 21 Apr 2024 | Arrive 8:00am - Depart 10:00pm

Culture and history await those who travel to Muscat. Shoppers will want to visit the Mutrah Souq to discover a colourful maze of vendors offering everything you could imagine. After, take a stroll along the Corniche to the Mutrah Fort for sweeping city views. And don't forget the Sultan Qaboos Grand Mosque – the third largest in the world and home to a must-see 600,000 crystal Swarovski chandelier!

Day 54: Doha, Qatar

Tue 23 Apr 2024 | Arrive 8:00am – Depart 8:00pm

Discover a modern oasis at the heart of an ancient city in Qatar. View invaluable artifacts at the Museum of Islamic Art, make your way through the Souq Waqif to shop like a local, or dine at IDAM – 3-Star Michelin Chef Alain Ducasse's outstanding restaurant. Cap your visit off with a stroll along the Al-Corniche, where you'll find breathtaking views of Doha Bay and the city's unmistakable skyline.

Day 55: Abu Dhabi, United Arab Emirates

Wed 24 Apr 2024 | Arrive 8:00am - Depart 10:00pm

Camels keep company with lavish sports cars in this dazzling city that is a seamless blend of architecture and culture from the old world and the new. Experience the grandeur of the gold-gilded Sheikh Zayed Grand Mosque, stroll along the seaside Corniche Road, or beat the desert heat at one of Abu Dhabi's chic, upscale shopping centres.

Days 56-57: Dubai, United Arab Emirates

Thu 25 – Fri 26 Apr 2024 | Arrive 8:00am on Day 56 – Depart 6:00pm on Day 57

Dubai is a city unlike any other in the world. What was once an endless desert is now home to many triumphs of modern technology, including the world's first underwater hotel, the world's tallest building, and the iconic Burj Al Arab. Spend your days exploring merchant stalls in the Dubai Gold Souk, and for an experience you'll have to see to believe, go skiing in the desert at Ski Dubai.

Days 58-59: At Sea

Day 60: Salalah, Oman

Mon 29 Apr 2024 | Arrive 8:00am - Depart 5:00pm

The city of Salalah is renowned for its khareef, the monsoon season from June to September that transforms this "Perfume Capital of Arabia" into an oasis. But this subtropical city has many other year-round natural sights to behold, including the waterfalls, lakes, mountains, the caves of Wadi Darbat, Mughsail Bay, and some of the most beautiful beaches in Oman.

Days 61-63: At Sea

Tue 30 Apr – Thu 2 May 2024


Day 64: Jeddah, Saudi Arabia

Fri 3 May 2024 | Arrive 8:00am – Depart 5:00pm

In ancient-meets-cosmopolitan Jeddah, the best of both worlds is always possible. This coastal metropolis is known as the "Mermaid of the Red Sea," welcoming visitors with seventh-century UNESCO-listed historic districts, a buzzing waterfront promenade, luxury shopping, state-of-theart architecture, and fine dining.

Day 66: Aqaba, Jordan

Sun 5 May 2024 | Arrive 8:00am - Depart 6:00pm

The stark deserts surrounding Petra are a sharp contrast to the snorkelling paradise of the Red Sea in this Jordanian port. Explore coral reefs and vibrantly coloured marine life in Aqaba, then travel inland to one of the world's great wonders – Petra. The massive stone facades of this ancient city are sure to take your breath away.

Days 67-68: Safaga (Luxor), Egypt

Mon 6 – Tue 7 May 2024 | Arrive 7:00am on Day 67 – Depart 5:00pm on Day 68

The Luxor Temple is home to the chapel of Alexander the Great. Then, continue on to Karnak, the largest religious site in the world. The Valley of the Kings is just a quick jaunt across the Nile, and its also the final resting place of King Tutankhamen. End your day onboard a felucca, and set sail as the sun starts to set over this mysterious land.

Day 69: Sokhna (Suez), Egypt

Wed 8 May 2024 | Arrive 7:00am - Depart 8:00pm

This state-of-the-art port is a striking contrast to the wonders of antiquity you will find in Cairo. The city unfolds in layers, beginning with the Great Pyramids of Giza, resting mysterious and silent on the sands of time, and the wealth of antiquities in the Egyptian Museum, where many stories are told.

Days 69-70: Suez Canal (Passage)

Wed 8 – Thu 9 May 2024 | Arrive 11:00pm on Day 69 – Depart 6:00pm on Day 70 $\,$

There's nothing quite like sailing through the Suez Canal. This voyage offers an opportunity to see the marvels of modern-day engineering that allow for travel between the Mediterranean and the Red Sea. A 100-mile

journey gives the illusion of sailing across an endless desert of ocean sand, a cruise through the Suez Canal is sure to provide memories to last a lifetime.

Day 71: Ashdod (Jerusalem), Israel

Fri 10 May 2024 | Arrive 7:30am – Depart 10:00pm

This ancient holy city won't fail to move you, regardless of your faith. From the Western Wall, to the Dome of the Rock, to the last remnants of the Temple of the Jews, Jerusalem is a woven tapestry of religion and history. Head to the modern Israel Museum and see the famous Dead Sea Scrolls for yourself.

Days 72-73: Haifa, Israel

Sat 11 – Sun 12 May 2024 | Arrive 7:30am on Day 72 – Depart 8:00pm on Day 73

Haifa is a modern city and seaport on the slopes of Mount Carmel, and is an excellent base for visiting biblical and archaeological sites. Within easy reach are the Galilee, Nazareth, the River Jordan, as well as Safed, a holy mountaintop city steeped in the mysticism of Kabbalah. Today it is also immersed in the arts, and studios and galleries abound.

Day 74: At Sea

Mon 13 May 2024

Day 75: Bodrum, Turkey

Tue 14 May 2024 | Arrive 8:00am – Depart 8:00pm

As the site of the ancient city of Halikarnassus, Bodrum's ties to the past are everywhere, like the Bodrum Amphitheatre, Myndos Gate, and Castle of St. Peter. But Bodrum is also a place where you really can leave the past behind, with modern-day pleasures like sailing, windsurfing, and diving, as well as beachfront bars and restaurants.







Day 76: Kusadasi (Ephesus), Turkey

Wed 15 May 2024 | Arrive 8:00am – Depart 10:00pm

Kusadasi has many charms, but let's talk Turkey: The star attraction is Ephesus. Once the second largest city in the Roman Empire, its marblemade Arcadian Street stretches from the 24,000-capacity Great Theatre (where St. Paul used to preach) to the harbour. Nearby sites include the Temple of Artemis, Basilica of St. John, and House of Virgin Mary, where Mary is supposed to have spent her last days.

Day 77: At Sea

Thu 16 May 2024

Days 78-79: Istanbul, Turkey

Fri 17 – Sat 18 May 2024 | Arrive 6:00am on Day 78 – Depart 6:00pm on Day 79

East meets West in the storied city where Europe and Asia meet. Start in Sultanahmet Square and you can easily explore the intricate architecture of Topkapi Palace, the cathedral-turned-mosque-turned-museum of Hagia Sofia, and the brilliant blues of the Sultan Ahmed Mosque. Sample kebaps, mezes and more at the city's endless restaurants and taverns where you're sure to meet friendly locals and be caught up in their infectious love of life.

Day 80: Varna, Bulgaria

Sun 19 May 2024 | Arrive 8:00am – Depart 6:00pm

A cosmopolitan city with a buried treasure in its past, the Black Sea port of Varna is perfect for strolling and taking in its history and beautiful mix of architecture. Check out that treasure for yourself – the Gold of Varna is on display at the Archaeological Museum – or meander your way around the stunning seaside park. No matter what you do, be sure to sample the region's fabled wines.

Day 81: Constanta, Romania

Mon 20 May 2024 | Arrive 8:00am – Depart 6:00pm

A cultural and economic centre for over 2,600 years, Constanta holds archaeological treasures and the charming atmosphere of the old town centre. Its historical monuments, ancient ruins, grand casino, museums and shops, and proximity to beach resorts make it a seaside gem that isn't on the map for most cruises. Plus, beautiful Bucharest is just a shore excursion away.

Day 82: Odessa, Ukraine

Tue 21 May 2024 | Arrive 8:00am – Depart 10:00pm

Founded by Katherine the Great, this brilliant jewel on the Black Sea boasts pastel-hued, neoclassical buildings, the bustling Pryvoz market, and the iconic Potemkin steps. Deribasovskaya Street is a pedestrian paradise with endless shops, cafes, and monuments, and the world-renowned Odessa Opera and Ballet Theater is an opulent blend of Viennese, Italian, and French architecture.

Day 83: At Sea

Wed 22 May 2024

Day 84: Kepez (Troy/Gallipoli), Turkey

Thu 23 May 2024 | Arrive 7:30am - Depart 2:00pm

Kepez is a small seaside town, but real treasures can be found when you explore further beyond the shore. The ancient city of Troy was once just a myth, but archaeological excavations have brought this fabled locale to life. Also within reach of port is the Gallipoli Peninsula, where an ill-fated WWI campaign devastated Allied forces. In Assos, the Temple of Athena sits perched on an acropolis with sweeping sea views





Day 85: Piraeus (Athens), Greece

Fri 24 May 2024 | Arrive 5:00am – Depart 8:00pm

Start your journey in Piraeus with an archaeological walk past landmarks like the Temple of Olympian Zeus, Ancient Agora, and of course, the Acropolis. Afterwards, head to the Central Market for a feast of fresh fruit and veggies, nuts, olives, and Grecian cheese. Finally, check out a local taverna where you can rub elbows with the locals.

Day 86: Santorini, Greece

Sat 25 May 2024 | Arrive 8:00am – Depart 9:00pm

The capital, Fira, clings to the rim of the caldera 900 feet above the sea. Take the cable car, or giddy up on a donkey to climb the 588 steps to the top. Hike to nearby Oia, a quintessential Greek village. Head south to the 3,500-year-old Minoan town Akrotiri. Often called Greece's answer to Pompeii, the well-preserved ruins provide a glimpse into Santorini's storied (and explosive) past.

Day 88: Katakolon (Olympia), Greece

Day 94: Dubrovnik, Croatia


Day 99: Monte Carlo, Monaco


Day 104: Malaga, Spain


